Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were LS Did Not Observe All of the Required Information on Each Child's Form. Provider Must Immediately Submit Evidence of Corrected Forms. (2), LS Observed the Children Being Served Snacks While Viewing a Video. Provider Is Reminded That Children May Not Eat Snacks While Viewing Technology and to Limit Viewing to No More Than 30 Minutes per Week of Passive Technology. (2), and LS Did Not Observe Evidence of Lead Testing for Each Child Born on or After January 1, 2015. Provider Must Immediately Submit Evidence of Lead Testing or an Appointment to Obtain a Lead Test From a Health Care Provider. (1). None of the 8 findings were critical.
