Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were At 10:22 the Provider Took All of the Child Care Children Into the Unapproved Kitchen Area to Prepare Milk for One of the Children in Care. LS Spoke with the Provider at This Inspection Prior to Her Taking All of the Children Into the Kitchen About the Approved Areas on the Initial Paperwork That H (3), One Child in Care Did Not Have Records Readily Available for the LS at This Inspection. The Records Were in Another Room of the House. Children Were Missing Daily Pick Up Person and Pediatrician on the Emergency Card. Health Inventory, Page 2, was Missing for One Child. Emergency Cards Were Missing F (2), and Two Children in Care Were Missing the Emergency Cards- One of Those Children Had a Card Present but Was Inaccessible to LS at This Inspection. Health Inventory Page 2 Was Missing for 1 Child and Health Inventory 1 Was Missing for 2 Children. (1). None of the 14 findings were critical.
