(2), At the Time of the Inspection, Specialist Observed Medication Administration Forms That Were Not Completed, They Were Not Reviewed by Staff and Signed and Dated. (2), and As Noted on 07/23/2025 Full Inspection Report, Several Staff Need to Be Fingerprinted Again. Staff Are to Be Fingerprinted Every 5 Years. It Has Been Over 5 Years Since 4 Staff Have Been Fingerprinted. (1). None of the 13 findings were critical.
