Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were OCC Was Not Notified That the Playground Was Not Accessible and the Children Could Not Go Outside. (1), For the Past Three Week, the Center Has Not Had Access to a Playground Due to Their Contract Expiring. They Are in the Process of Renegotiating It. (1), and When LS Called the Center to Inquire About the Playground the Person Who Answered the Phone Said That the Director Was Not There and That There Was No One Designated to Be in Charge During Their Absence. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
