The Provider Was on the Main Level with 5 Children One Child Was Upstairs Crying. The Provider Has a Monitor That Has Sound However at One Point the Provider Left the 5 Children Downstairs and Went Upstairs to Get the Crying Child. She Left the 5 Children for Ap (2), and The RM Asked to Observe Daily Attendance to Access Compliance for Children Under 2 in Care. The Provider Could Not or Would Not Provide the Documentation as Required. (1). None of the 10 findings were critical.
