Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were LS Observed 1 Emergency Card That Was Not Complete, Specifically Missing the Physician's Information. Provider to Submit a Written Statement Verifying That the Emergency Card Is Completed, Obtained, and Accessible in the Child's File. (2), LS Observed No Evidence of Fire Drills Conducted Since June, 2025. Provider to Submit a Memorandum of Understanding of the Regulation and the Importance of Maintaining a Log of the Fire Drills and Emergency Disaster Drills Conducted. (2), and LS Observed No Evidence of Milk in the Refrigerator. Provider to Submit Photographic Evidence That Whole Milk and Skim or Fat Free Milk Has Been Obtained and Is Accessible to the Children in Care. (1). None of the 7 findings were critical.
