(1), LS Observed Child Files That Were Missing Written Records That Meet the Requirements of This Regulation. Facility to Submit Evidence That All Child Files Have All Required Forms and Written Records Required in This Regulation. (1), and LS Observed Daily Schedules That Provided Meals More Than 3 Hours Apart. Facility to Revise and Submit Daily Schedules That Provide Meals No More Than 3 Hours Apart. (1).
