Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were LS Conducted Follow Up Monitoring Inspection on 3.24.26 - During the Walkthrough LS Observed That There Are Many Areas of Chipping and Peeling Paint Throughout the Facility on Walls and Doors. (2), LS Observed Classrooms Covered by Staff That Had Not Been Cleared and Aides Assigned to Classrooms. (2), and Several Refrigerators Were Registering Above 40 Degrees. (B2 @ 42 Degrees, B1 @ 48 Degrees. (2). None of the 14 findings were critical.
