Across 2 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were LS Observed Items in a Closet That Did Not Have a Child Safety Lock on It That Had Potentially Harmful Items in It. The Director Was Unsure if That Closet Remained Locked with a Key, Although She Did Try Her Keys to See if She Could Lock It During the Inspection She Was Unsuccessful at the Time. (2), LS Received a Personnel List with a Staff That Was Unknown to OCC Listed on It During the Inspection LS Asked When Was This Staff Added to the List and the Director Explained That This Staff Had Been Here Since She Started in July Being Used Only as a Substitute and She Did Not Know That This Staff (1), and The Center Added a New Employee to the Center in March Without Notifying the Office of Childcare No Qualifying Documentation Had Been Sent to the Office for This Employee. (1). None of the 8 findings were critical.
