(2), Licensing Specialist Found No Evidence of Training for an Aide Who Started in August 2020. (2), and The Center Did Not Report the End Date of One Staff Member. The Center Stated That They Also Had Two Substitutes, but They Are No Longer Employees. The Center Was Reminded About This Regulation. (1). None of the 9 findings were critical.
