Across 5 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Room 4 Had a Mixed Age Group of 3 Toddlers and 10 Two Year Olds at the Time of the Inspection with Ms Julie and Ms Liah. (3), LS Interviewed Staff and Confirmed That AC Has Vaped Both Inside and Outside of the Premises. AC Was Reminded That the Regulations State That Vaping Is Prohibited at All Times Inside the Childcare Facility. (2), and Facility Has Four Classrooms with Aides Assigned for Supervision and No Qualified Teachers in Those Rooms. (2). None of the 13 findings were critical.
