The Principal Was Unaware if the Person Who Did the Heimlich on the Child Was Aware of the Staff Person Who Had First Aid and CPR. (1), A Child Choked on a Piece of Candy. (1), and A Second Grader Choked on a Round Hard Candy. The Principal Was Told That the Candy Was Given to This Child's Older Sibling and the Sibling Gave the Candy to His Younger Sibling. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
