Facility Must Submit Documentation for the Child to Remain in Preschool or Disenroll the Child. (1), At the Time of Inspection, One Child with Asthma Indicated Did Not Have the Required Asthma Action Plan. Facility Must Receive This Documentation Immediately and Submit Evidence to LS. (1), and At the Time of Inspection, LS Observed Expired Benadryl for a Child with Allergies. The Facility Must Discard or Return This Medication to Parents Immediately. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
