Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Specialist Did Not Observe the Provider Wash Her Hands After Diapering . (2), Specialist Observed 5 Children's File; And Two Children's Emergency Form Was Missing an Enrollment Date, Two Children's Emergency Form Was Missing Authorized Pick Up Person, One Childs Emergency Form Was Missing the Expected Days and Hours of Attendance , Speclist Observed Four Children Missing Lead (1), and Specialist Observed a Soiled Diaper in a Open Plastic Bag on Top of the Changing Pad.
