(2), LS Observed an Infant in a Pack and Play with Their Bottle, Provider Is Reminded That Infants Must Be Held to Feed and Cannot Be in Their Pack and Play Feeding. LS Also Observed One Infant with a Bib and Pacifier Leash in Their Pack and Play and Another Infant in the Pack and Play with a Teething To (1), and Provider Was Unable to Produce Children's Files Containing All the Required Documentation as Required by the Office of Child Care.
