Please Forward a Written Statement to the OCC Explaining That You Will Have a Qualified Staff Person in Charge of the After Care Children at All Times. (1), and The Center Was Not Aware That They Needed to Give the Parent of Each Enrolled Child a Written Screen Time Policy.
