Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were LS Did Not Observe Parental Permission for One Child's Medication. (3), LS Observed One Child's Emergency Form Missing the Child's Physician information. LS Observed One Child's Emergency Form Missing the Annual Parental Update. (1), and LS Observed One Child Missing Lead Testing results. LS Observed Four Children Missing the 2nd Lead Test Results. (1). None of the 14 findings were critical.
