Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Observed an Infant Room with Two Infants and One Aide, and a Toddler/two Room with Four Children and One Aide. Facility Is Reminded They Must Have Qualified Staff at All Times. (2), Per Previous Inspection Licensing Specialist Reviewed Several Children's Files and Found That the Emergency Cards Were Still Missing Information and Several Were Missing the Second Page. (1), and Licensing Specialist Interviewed Several Staff Regarding Abuse and Neglect Reporting. Most Staff Said They Report to the County, One Said They Report to the Parents and Have a Discussion with the Children. Staff Are Reminded That They Are Mandated Reporters and Obligated to Report Any Suspected Abus (1). None of the 13 findings were critical.
