(2), LS Reviewed Children's Files and Observed That 4 Files Were Missing the Consumer Education Pamphlet. (1), and LS Reviewed Children's Files and Observed That 8 Files Were Missing One or Both Lead Screening or Tests. (1). None of the 14 findings were critical.
