Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Classroom 5, 3 Had Aides in Charge of Groups Not Giving Adequate Supervision and Room 5 LS Observed Leave the Classroom Multiple Times to Answer or Walk Parents to the Door Leaving an Aide in Charge of Groups. (3), Child Was Struck in the Back of the Head by a Staff Member in the 3 Year Old Classroom. This Violates Abuse, Neglect, Mental Injury, or Injurious Treatment to a Child. (1), and A Child Was Struck in the Back of the Head by a Staff Member in the 3 Year Old Classroom and Does Not Support the Discipline Regulations Which States for the Child's Maturity, and Physical Condition. (1). None of the 13 findings were critical.
