Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Child Discipline Was Not Appropriate to the Age, Maturity and Physical Condition of the Child. (2), A Three Year Old Child Was Left Alone on the Playground for About 5-6 Minuets. Child Was Stopped by a Parent Entering the Gate to Drop a Child Off. A Staff Person Observed the Child on the Playground as the Staff Person Held the Door Open for Another Group of Children to Go Outside. (1), and Supervision Was Not Adequate, a Child Was Left on the Playground for 5-6 Minutes Without Adult Supervision. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
