Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were At the Time of Inspection Four of the Five Emergency Forms Needed to Be Updated. (6), At the Time of Inspection the Counter Between the Child Care Area and the Kitchen Was Congested with Items Which Included a Plate with Snack, Swiffer Wet Jet Cleaner, Toys, Used Bottles and Empty Water Bottles. This Space Should Be Cleared of All Toys, Old Food and Empty Bottles. The Swiffer Wet J (3), and Blankets Used for Cushioning the Sleep Surface in the Pack N Play. (2). None of the 14 findings were critical.
