Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Child Was Released to a Complete Stranger. The Stranger Was Able to Exit the Building with the Child. (2), A Child Was Released to a Stranger, That Was Not Cleared to Be with the Child. (2), and Staff Site Director Released a Child to a Stranger. The Site Director Did Not Follow Policies and Procedures That Have Been Put in Place by the Center. The Person Was Able to Exit the Building with the Child. Fortunately They Did Not Leave the Parking Lot and Returned the Child. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
