Provider Served Whole Grapes to Children, Licensing Specialist Instructed the Provider That She Needs to Cut the Grapes to Avoid Choking. (1), and Provider Served Whole Grapes to Children, Licensing Specialist Instructed Provider to Cut the Grapes to Avoid Any Choking. (1). None of the 10 findings were critical.
