Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were LS Interviewed the Family Services Coordinator Who Stated That Children Play in the Gym When They Are Unable to Play on the Playground. LS Did Not Observe Children in the Gym on October 3, 2025. (1), Licensing Specialist Did Not Observe Blood Lead Testing Results for a Second Blood Lead Testing Done on March 2, 2022. This Child's First Lead Blood Test Result Done on April 7, 2021 Indicates an Elevated Blood Lead Level of 4.2. (1), and Licensing Specialist Observed Multiple Holes in the Protective Surfacing on the Ground Creating a Potential Tripping Hazard. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
