Across 1 inspection since 2023, the issues cited most often were Licensing Specialist Was Not Able to Observe Appropriate Rest Furnishings for Three Children Over the Age of 2. Provider Has Written Requests by Parents to Have the Children Remain in a Porta-crib, Which Is Not Approved for Children Over the Age of 2. (1) and Licensing Specialist Observed One Child's Emergency Form Indicating There Is a Medical Condition, Asthma. There Is a Medication Authorization Form and an Asthma Action Plan, but No Medication at the Child Care Program. (1). None of the 2 findings were critical.
