During the Interim inspection, licensing consultant Laura Piacentini found 3 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. The corrective action plan may be submitted in the [Child Care Hub Information Record Portal \(CCHIRP\)](#). The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.

- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Due to the health and safety professional development training violation(s), all of the facility's child care staff members must complete the required training by 6/11/2024. This must be included in the facility's corrective action plan.
