Across 1 inspection since 2019, the issues cited most often were March 12, 2020 - The Administrative Law Judge Concludes That It Is More Likely Than Not That: (A) the Abuse Alleged in the Notice of and Order for Hearing Did Not Occur; (B) the Determination of Maltreatment Is Erroneous; (C) the Disqualification Is Improper; And (D) the Conditional License and Fine Are Not warranted.
