Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were The Requirements for Sleeping Materials Were Not Met as Evidenced by 4 Children 12 Months or Older, Who Nap or Sleep, Did Not Have a Sheet. (3) and A Gun Was Not Locked in a Cabinet or a Closet as Evidenced by It Was on the Ground in the Locked Basement. The Basement Was a Part of Their Emergency Preparedness Plan and in an Emergency the Children Would Have Had Access. (2). None of the 5 findings were critical.
