(4) and A Caregiver Exhibited Behavior That Did Not Show the Individual to Be of Good Character and Intent and Qualified to Provide Care to Children as Evidenced by During a Facility Review Conference Conducted on April 23, 2024, Director Dorothy Miller Stated That Tara Robinson Was Fired and No Longer Work (1).
