Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were The Facility Did Not Have a Fenced Outdoor Play Area That Was on or Adjoining the Day Care Property and Was Accessible Without Hazard as Evidenced by the Fence Had Openings That Were Between 3.5 and 9 Inches and Allow Entrapment - the Openings Measured Two Wood Fence Slats Are Missing Leaving 6" Gap (4) and The Family Care Safety Registry Check Was Not Conducted for GERALYN CERVENY, KEN CERVENY, KENDRA CERVENY Within Thirty (30) Days Prior to the Anniversary Date.
