(3) and Requirements for Supervision of Napping Children Were Not Met as Evidenced by Infants and Toddlers Did Not Have Constant Care and Supervision in That Raelene Burchfield Was in the Restroom and Brynn Feigenspan Stepped Into the Laundry Room and Door Was Shut Behind Her..
