Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Facility Did Not Submit the 2026 Annual Summary Report Showing Immunization Status of Each Child Enrolled by January 15. (2), Sleeping Equipment Was Not Arranged to Provide Required Spacing as Evidenced by the Aisle on the Long Side of the Napping Equipment Was Too Narrow - the Space Measured Less Than 24 Inches. (2), and Lighting Requirements for Rooms Used by Children Were Not Met as Evidenced by Lighting Was Insufficient to Observe and Supervise Children in That Eyes Had to Adjust to the Darkness of the Preschool Room. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
