Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were The Facility Did Not Have a Fenced Outdoor Play Area That Was on or Adjoining the Day Care Property and Was Accessible Without Hazard as Evidenced by the Fence Had Openings Large Enough for a Child to Crawl or Fall Through - the Opening Measured Approximately Five Inches by Two Feet. (5). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **The Facility's Outdoor Space Was Not Safe/well-maintained for Children's Activities as Evidenced by the Gate, to the Left of the Porch, That Blocks Off the Narrow Walkway Between the Porch and Fence/ exterior Gate Is Not Secured to the Post. The Gate Is Falling Over.**

- **The Facility's Outdoor Space Was Not Safe/well-maintained for Children's Activities as Evidenced by the Four Nails Protruding From the Fence Near the Front Right Corner of the Outdoor Play Space.**
