Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Medical Examination Report(s) Was/were Not on File for Jayla Coleman, Kelsey Singer, DeeDee Wallace, Annie Hindes, and Sydney Switzer as Evidenced by a Medical Examination Was Not on File Within 30 Days of an Individual Beginning to Work with Children. (2), The Family Care Safety Registry Check Was Not Conducted for Sydney Switzer Within Thirty (30) Days Prior to the Anniversary Date. (1), and The Facility's Outdoor Space Was Not Safe for Children's Activities as Evidenced by Six Metal Pole Structures Located in the Picnic Table Space, Directly Outside the Classrooms Had Excessive Rust and Peeling/chipping Paint. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
