Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were The Facility's Outdoor Space Was Not Safe/well-maintained for Children's Activities as Evidenced by Landscaping Tarp Was Showing Through the Mulch Posing as a Trip Hazard. (3), The Smoke Detector Located in the Furnace Room Was Chirping. (1), and Outdoor Equipment, Pink Playhouse, in the Outdoor Play Area Was Not in Good Condition as Evidenced by a Crack Was Located Near the Base of the Door. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
