Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were The Fall-zone Area Under and Around Outdoor Equipment Where Children Might Fall and Be Injured Was Not Covered with Impact-absorbing Materials to Cushion a Fall as Evidenced by Bare Ground Around Fall Zone of Little Climber/slide. (4) and Requirements for Supervision of Napping Children Were Not Met as Evidenced by the Caregiver Was Too Far Away to Hear All Children. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
