Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were TB Reports on File Were Older Than 24 Months for Grace Replogle, Megan Borders and Rebekah Simmerman. (3), The Equipment, a Slide and Swings, That Is Over 24 Inches High, Does Not Have Sufficient Impact Absorbing Material Present as Evidenced by Resilient Surface Needs to Be Replaced Where Bare Ground Is Visible. (1), and The Facility's Admitting Procedure Did Not Include an Individualized Special Care Plan for a Child with Special Needs. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
