Across 1 inspection since 2023, the issues cited most often were Diapering Requirements Were Not Met as Evidenced by the Diapering Table Was Not Located Where Caregiver Could Maintain Supervision of His/her Group of Children. The Diapering Table Was Located Against the Wall, and the Caregiver Would Have Their Backs to the Group in Both of the Infant/toddler Room (4) and Outdoor Equipment, Climber with Slide and Rocking Horse, in the Play Yard Was Not Free of Sharp Parts as Evidenced by the Plastic Climbing Handles on the Climber/slide Are Broken and the Plastic Rocking Horse Has a Hole in It's Head That Is Sharp. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
