Across 1 inspection since 2023, the issues cited most often were The Premises Were Not Safe and Suitable as Evidenced by Additional Metal Fence Material and a Metal Pole Were Discovered in the Outdoor Play Area . (3), The Requirements for Medications to Be in the Original Container with Proper Labeling Were Not Met as Evidenced by a Medication Was Not in Its Original Container - the Medication Was Contained in a Plastic, Zip Loc Baggie. (1), and Requirements for the Outdoor Play Area Were Not Met as Evidenced by the Fence Had Openings That Were Greater Than 3 1/2 Inches and Allow Entrapment - the Openings Measured 5 Inches by 2 Inches in the Gate and a Hole Near a Trash Can Measured 12 Inches by 5 Inches in the Preschool Play Area . (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
