Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were The Facility Did Not Have a Fenced Outdoor Play Area That Was on or Adjoining the Day Care Property and Was Accessible Without Hazard as Evidenced by the Fence Had Openings That Were Between 3.5 and 9 Inches and Allow Entrapment - the Openings Measured 4.5 Inches at the Bottom of the Gate by the Sid (5). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **The Ceilings Located in the Pink Room Right as You Walk in the Doorway Was/were Not in Good Condition as Evidenced by the Ceiling Tile Was Sagging and Pulled Away From the Metal Grid.**

- **The Floors Located General Walkway Near the Plastic Play Yard Was/were Not in Good Condition as Evidenced by a Square Whole in About 3 in by 3 in Cut Out in the Carpet, Could Be a Tripping Hazard.**
