Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were Requirements of 19 CSR 30-61.086 Fire Safety Were Not Met as Evidenced by the Disaster and Tornado Drill Record Was Not Available on the Premises. (2), Bathroom Supplies Were Not Available and Accessible to Children as Evidenced by Toilet Paper Was Not Within Children's Reach. (1), and Requirements of Facility's Participation in Disaster and Emergency Drills Were Not Met as Evidenced by the Disaster or Emergency Drill Was Not Held at Least One Time Every Three Months. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
