Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Menus for All Meals and Snacks Were Not Current or Posted Where Easily Seen by Parents and Cook. (1), Shelter-in-place or Lockdown Drills Were Not Practiced Every Three Months And/or Drill Record Was Incomplete. (1), and Health and Safety Training Topics Were Not Included as Part of On-going Training Within Five Years of Completing the Previous Health and Safety Training Topics. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **Health and Safety Training Topics Were Not Included as Part of On-going Training Within Five Years of Completing the Previous Health and Safety Training Topics.**

Two staff members have not completed all the health and safety trainings for the 5 year mark. Violation confirmed corrected
