Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (2), All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing. (1), and Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

● **All Stationary Equipment, More Than 18 Inches High, Was Not Installed Over Protective Surfacing.**

On the playgrounds used for school-age and pre-k children, the mulch underneath and around the structures must be at least 9 inches in depth. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received

● **A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children.**

There were tree limbs hanging over the fence on the school-age playground. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 2/26/2026

● **Medications Including Prescription and Non-prescription Items Were Not Stored in a Locked Cabinet or Other Locked Container.**

One child had an action plan. All necessary documentation was with the medication. The medication and forms were located in the office and not with the child. T
