Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair. (1), The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment. (1), and All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

- **All Walls and Ceilings Including Doors and Windows Were Not Kept Clean, Free of Visible Fungal Growth, and in Good Repair.**

The walls in indoor spaces #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, and #9 have chipped paint areas that need to be repaired. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from pro

- **The Depth of the Loose Surfacing Was Not Based on Critical Height of the Equipment.**

The depth of the mulch in older preschool children's outdoor space under the large climbing structure was not nine (9) inches. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/30/202

- **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**

There was a hole in the wall and chipped paint on the walls in indoor space #6. Indoor space #7 had chipped paint on the walls and a wall display in the science area with broken wood and chipped paint. Violation confirmed correcte
