(1), Running Water, Soap and Individual Sanitary Towels, or Other Approved Hand-drying Devices Were Not Supplied at Each Lavatory. (1), and Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

Running water was unavailable in the facility. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 2/24/2026

● **Plastic Bags, Materials That Could Be Torn Apart and Toy Parts Small Enough to Be Swallowed Were Accessible to Children Under Three Years of Age.**

Plastic bags accessible to children under age three were observed on a table and on the floor across from the bathroom. Violation confirmed

● **All Electrical Appliances Were Not Used in Accordance with the Manufacturers Instruction.**

Appliances with heating elements, such as bottle warmers, crock pots, curling irons, irons, coffee pots, and/or their cords were accessible to preschool-age children. A hot glue gun was in use an
