Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Enhanced Staff/child Ratios and Group Sizes Were Not Met. (1), Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times. (1), and Fire Drills Were Not Practiced Monthly And/or the Drill Record Was Incomplete. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

During naptime there were three (3) children aged three years old and six (6) children aged two years old with one (1) caregiver. Violation corrected during visit

● **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

Children ages four and five years old were allowed to leave the classroom and walk across the hallway to use the bathroom while two (2) staff members stayed inside the classroom with other children. Violation confirmed corrected by

● **Fire Drills Were Not Practiced Monthly And/or the Drill Record Was Incomplete.**

Fire drills were not completed for the months of February and March 2025. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 4/27/2025

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**
