Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were A Safe Indoor and Outdoor Environment Was Not Provided for the Children. (1), The Indoor And/or Outdoor Premises Was Not Checked Once a Day, Prior to Initial Use, Ensuring Debris, and Broken Equipment Was Removed and Disposed Of. (1), and Daily Records of Arrival and Departure Times for Children Enrolled at the Center Were Not Maintained as Children Arrive and Depart And/or Were Not Made... (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

An outlet, under the back left window in space 4 is no longer flush with the sheetrock and is coming out of the wall. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/7/2025

● **The Indoor And/or Outdoor Premises Was Not Checked Once a Day, Prior to Initial Use, Ensuring Debris, and Broken Equipment Was Removed and Disposed Of.**

Today I observed a dead blue jay being eaten by insects on the playground. The staff on the playground at the time reported they were

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● **All Equipment and Furnishings Were Not in Good Repair.**
