(1), and Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs... (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.

The menu listed that corn was served for lunch, but green beans were served and no change was documented on the menu. Violation corrected during visit

There was no thermometer in the refrigerator in space 3. Violation corrected during visit

● **Electrical Outlets and Power Strips, Not in Use, Which Were Located in Space Used by Children Did Not Have Safety Outlets or Were Not Covered with Safety Plugs...**
