A seasonal employee did not complete the trainings within one year of employment. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provider on 7/17/2025

- **Children Were Not Adequately Supervised at All Times.**

On April 2, 2025, a child two years of age was left on the playground unattended for 5 minutes. Violation confirmed corrected by follow-up visit made by consultant on 4/28/2025

Jan 23, 2025 2 Findings ● 2 Important

- **A Copy of the Safe Sleep Policy Was Not Given to And/or Explained to the Parent of Each Child on or Before the First Day the Infant Attended the Center.**

A child's file was missing the acknowledgement of the safe sleep policy. Violation confirmed corrected by letter received from provi
